CRITERIA TO APPLY

Each applicant must be a high school senior enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited Northern California (NCGA boundaries) high school. Each applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan on attending a four-year college or university during the fall of the same year the scholarship is awarded.

Completed applications and all supporting documents such as letters of recommendation and transcripts must be postmarked by May 30, 2008. In an autobiographical essay of no more than 1,000 words, discuss significant experiences, community involvement and the qualities of character and leadership that have been important in achieving your goals. Highlight those personal accomplishments, achievements and experiences that have given you considerable satisfaction and have helped to form your character. Be sure to comment on your aspirations in terms of your future educational and career goals.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

All applicants must submit two letters of recommendation to be considered for this scholarship. All letters of recommendation should be sent directly from the author to the NCGA in a signed, sealed envelope. At least one letter of recommendation should be written by a high school teacher.
