

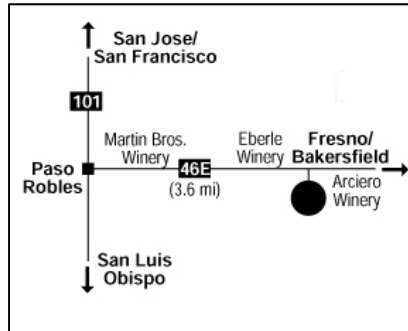


**NCGA JUNIOR TOUR FALL SERIES V

PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read carefully.

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day. Boys Championship Flight will play from the **BLUE** tee yardages. Girls Championship Flight and the Boys First Flight will play from the **WHITE** yardages. Girls First Flight will play from the **RED** yardages.

RULES OF PLAY: The **2008-2009** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition. The "One Ball Rule" is **not** in effect.

1ST TEE TIME: 8:00 AM off tees 1 and 10. Tee times for the second round will begin at 8:00 AM.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUND: If you wish to play a practice round you must make reservations by calling the **Hunter Ranch Golf Course.**

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason **MUST** notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a **NO SHOW** and the player will receive a **ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION.** A player who only contacts the course and **NOT** the NCGA will incur the suspension.

SUBSTITUTIONS: **THERE ARE NO SUBSTITUTIONS ALLOWED FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP.**

LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page players in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and all players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. See "Time of Starting" in the NCGA rules card.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

DRESS CODE: Refer to NCGA rules card.

PLAY-OFF: There will be a play-off for first in each flight if necessary. Ties for second will be broken by a scorecard playoff. Duplicate medals will be awarded to third place finishers in each flight. Ties for net will be broken by scorecards.

PRO SHOP & RANGE: Open at 7:00 AM.

FOOD SERVICE: **Restaurant opens at 7:00 AM.** Lunch will be provided each day. If a player stops between nines and loses position, the player will be penalized for slow play.
