



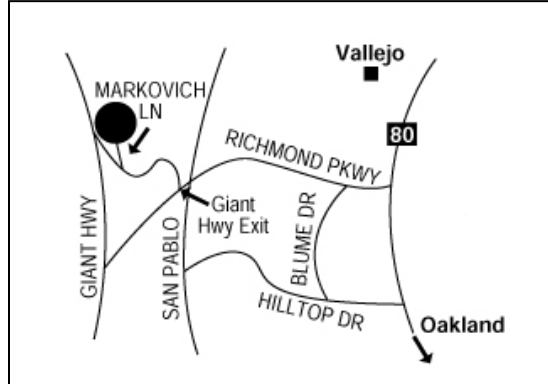
USGA SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING

CONTESTANT INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information pertinent to the qualifying site where you have been assigned.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play. Contestants will play from the **BLUE** tee YARDAGE. Those who qualify will advance to the championship at Lake Nona Golf and Country Club, Orlando, Florida, October 2-7, 2010. There will be a playoff immediately following play to determine the last qualifying spot and/or alternates if necessary.

QUALIFYING SPOTS: The number of spots available at each qualifying site will be determined based on the total number of national entrants and the final field at each site. The final number of spots will be available from the Committee on the day of qualifying.

CERTIFICATES: If you are a qualifier, it is important that you pick up your certificate from the Committee prior to leaving the qualifier.

RULES OF PLAY: The 2010-2011 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the USGA Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the qualifying or championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition. **The "One-Ball Rule" will be in effect.**

GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEMS AND HAND HELD RANGE FINDERS are NOT permitted during USGA Championships and Qualifiers. Penalty - DISQUALIFICATION

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: The use of automotive transportation is permissible for PLAYERS ONLY. Caddies must walk at all times during stipulated round. Spectator carts will not be allowed. Carts are \$15.

DRESS CODE: PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired both on the golf course and premises of the club. Blue jeans, designer jeans, T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Collared shirts must be worn and be tucked. Shorts, if worn, must be no shorter than mid-thigh (no jean shorts). **DRESS CODE IS THE SAME FOR MEN AND WOMEN.**

FOOTWEAR: Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice Rounds will be available Friday (9/3), Saturday (9/4), Sunday (9/5) after 12 noon, and Monday (9/6) after 2 pm. Call the Richmond Pro Shop, 510-232-7815, to arrange a practice round. Cost is \$50. Carts are \$15. Payment can be made by cash, credit card or reciprocal charge.

PRO SHOP & RANGE: The Pro Shop and driving range will open at 6:30 AM on the day of the competition.

FOOD SERVICE: The Clubhouse will be open for breakfast from 6-9 AM. The 10th Tee Snack Shack will be open from 9 AM - 3 PM. Cash, Credit Card, or Reciprocal Charge accepted.

REFUNDS: The USGA will refund the entry fees in the event of injury or illness, if requested by October 2, 2010. A \$25.00 service charge will be deducted from all refunds. No refunds for any reason after October 2. **REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST BE DIRECTED TO THE USGA AT (908) 234-2300.**
